Honeybees spend their life pollinating, gathering nectar, and condensing that nectar into honey.

Over its short lifetime, a single honeybee's contribution of honey to its hive is 1/12 of a teaspoon, yet an entire hive can produce 60-100 pounds of honey in a year.

Thinking small in a world so large—with so many needs—might feel overwhelming. But the lesson of the honeybee teaches each of us that even 1/12 of a teaspoon can produce something sweet.
